

HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT OF GENERAL POLICY

- Review and revise the company health and safety policy at regular intervals and also where necessary due to changes in company activities or feedback from consultation.
- Safeguard the occupational health and safety of third parties affected by the company's working practices.
- Identify hazards and minimise the risk of harm so far as reasonably practicable through a process of assessment, control, instruction, training and supervision.
- Fully and effectively control the health and safety risks arising from our work activities in co-operation with other contractors, clients and designers.
- Ensure that all plant and equipment owned, used or hired by the company is safe, properly maintained, inspected and tested.
- Ensure that all equipment, materials and substances used by the company are used, handled and stored safely.
- Ensure that all employees are provided with adequate information, instruction and training to competently carry out their work activities.
- Ensure that accident and ill health prevention is provided the highest priority, proportionate with business objectives.
- Ensure that all working places are maintained in a safe and healthy condition.
- Provide adequate resources, including sufficient finance and access to competent health and safety advice, to achieve the aims of the policy.

The Board of Directors accept their mutual responsibilities and have appointed Simon French to champion health and safety management within the company. It is the responsibility of all employees to implement this policy in accordance with the company procedural arrangements.
