FORGE WOOD COMMUNITY CENTRE

THE DETAIL

The new community centre is founded on conventional foundations, suspended block and beam slab with a partial steel frame and masonry externals. Using brick and block around the frame, the building also features yellow and red brick featuring quoins and corbelling details as shown in our photos.

The main hall has sliding partition doors subdividing the rooms and allowing for flexibility in its use. The floor is sprung oak with a separate hall, kitchen and two servery areas to the café space. There are seven additional storage rooms for community use.

WHITEHOUSE FARM SPORTS PAVILION / PITCH

New community sports pavilion and sports pitches at Clay Lane,
White House Farm, Chichester, part of the client's S106 requirements.

THE DETAIL

Two adult football pitches, a cricket square and a rugby pitch.
Internally there is a kitchen, clubroom, officials changing
facilities with toilets and showers, two rugby changing rooms
with toilets and showers and two football changing rooms.

The Pavilion's split level roof enables natural lighting and ventilation
to the core area, and the roof accommodates a large PV array.

This project was carried out in conjunction with a new
£1.5m rising main and pumping station for the wider
housing development – see aerial picture below.



BORDON & OAKHANGER SPORTS CLUB PAVILION, WHITEHILL & BORDON

THE DETAIL

The site of the former BOSC pavilion was proposed for a major revamp with a new building facilitating football, tennis and cricket sporting facilities, a clubroom, restaurant and large private room for hire.

The design drew on the heritage buildings nearby and a traditional pavilion design – set to overlook the newly formed cricket pitch.

The building was originally the army officers' cricket pavilion and the colonial style is historically important to Bordon and its military past, which was highlighted in the design code.

The new building provides function and dining rooms for local events and clubs as well as a striking pavilion for cricket, bowls and tennis groups in the town.

PADDOCK BAR, SALISBURY RACECOURSE

THE DETAIL

Modernisation, refurbishment and improvement of existing facilities of the very popular Paddock Bar, Salisbury Racecourse.

Comprised a new fibre-cement grey cladding system to all elevations and a new highly insulated roof. Full-width bi-folding doors to the frontage now allow racegoers improved circulation and uninterrupted views of the Parade Ring with the new bound gravel hard standings and the raised, enclosed decking area again improving views across the course.

Internal transformation includes a larger, more modern bar area.

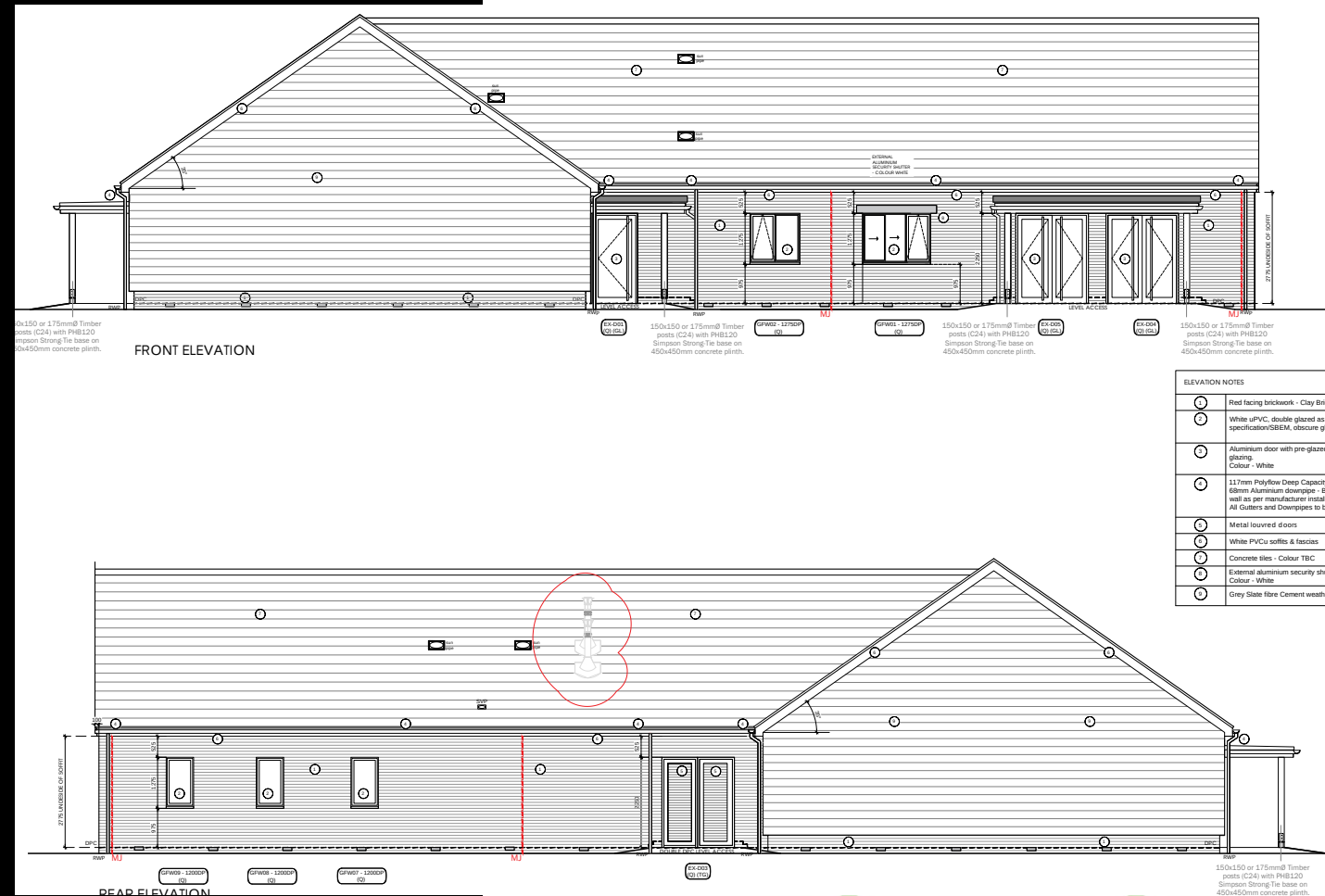
FORGE WOOD SPORTS PITCH AND PAVILION

THE DETAIL

To meet the needs of a new housing development, we were appointed to build a new sports pitch and pavilion. Working to Sports England requirements, this project involved design and construction of the pavilion and a natural turf facility including a cricket outfield, cricket square and drainage pitch. The sports pitch was undertaken by Bourne Sport with all other areas managed by Mildren Construction.

CHURCH CROOKHAM SPORTS PAVILION

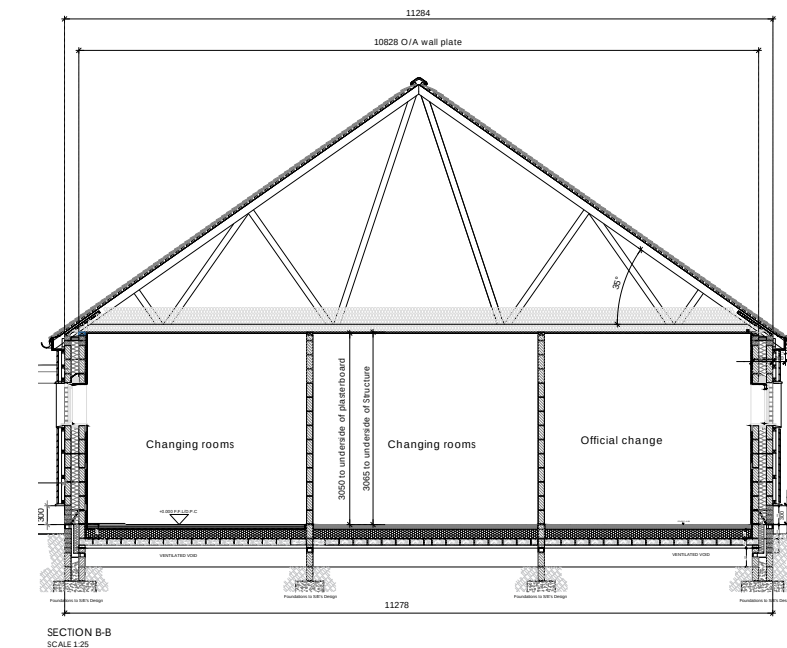

CHURCH CROOKHAM COMMUNITY CENTRE

THE DETAIL

New, multi-use community building on the former Queen Elizabeth II Barracks at Church Crookham in Fleet. Features a double height hall with north facing skylights.

The new contemporary building provides flexible accommodation for the local community and Parish Council including a 120 seat hall, nursery for 30 children and Parish Office.
